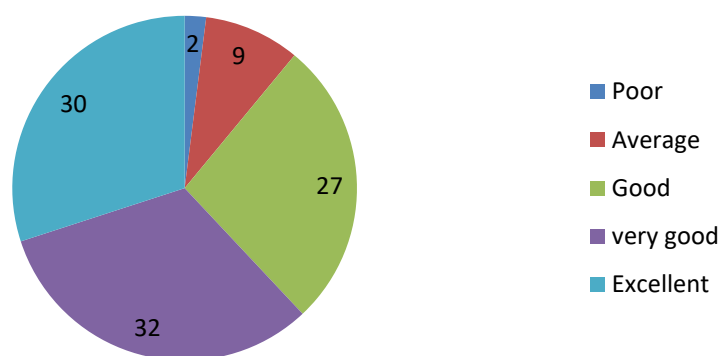

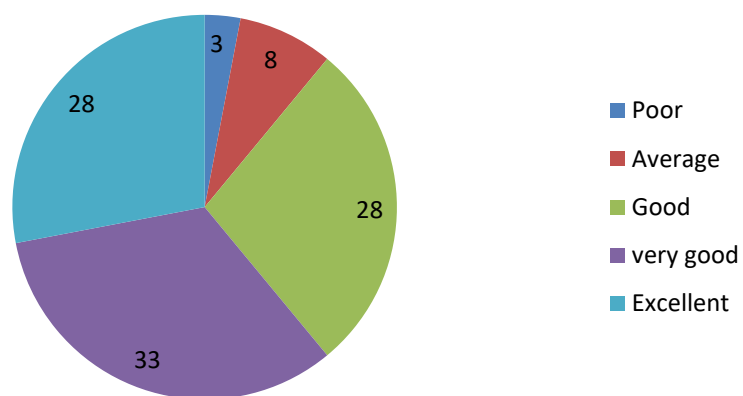
Structure of CBCS curriculum



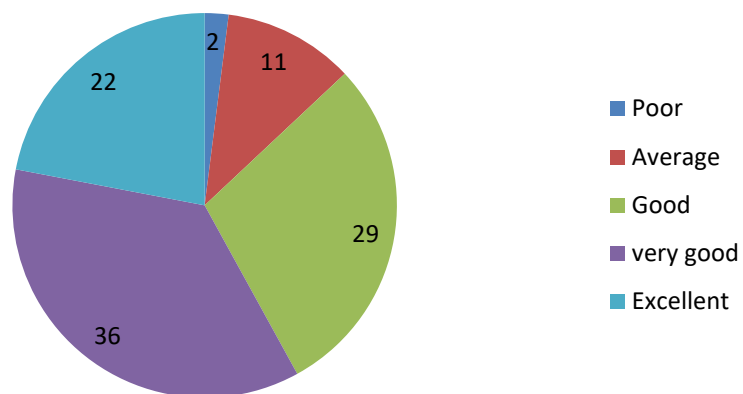

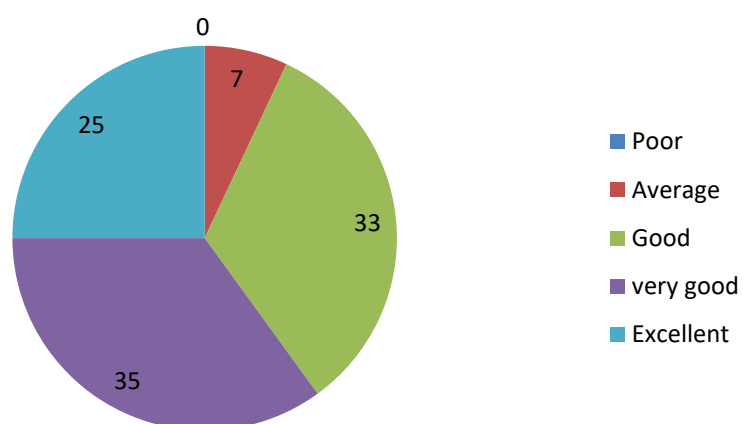
Pattern of curriculum evaluation



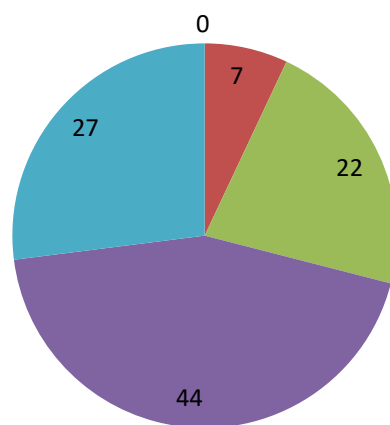

Action Taken Report of the Institution on Feedback 2023 - 24

IQAC has Conducted survey on Teaching Learning process and collected feedback on the coverage of the syllabus, Student centric methods adopted, communication Skills of the Teachers, availability of suitable equipment/ Software in laboratories and usage of ICT facilities.

The Feedback optioned is discussed in meeting with the Head of the Departments. Necessary Actions are taken in the form of sending circular to department and the students as follows:

- I. It is resolved to increase the number of referral books in the library as per the new syllabus.

Action Taken Report of the Institution on Feedback

IQAC has Conducted survey on Teaching Learning process and collected feedback on the coverage of the syllabus, Student centric methods adopted, communication Skills of the Teachers, availability of suitable equipment/ Software in laboratories and usage of ICT facilities.

The Feedback optioned is discussed in meeting with the Head of the Departments. Necessary Actions are taken in the form of sending circular to department and the students as follows:

- We introduced the Centralized Internal Examination system.
- We motivated the staff to encourage the students to join in PG Courses by providing Coaching.

- Sport and games facilities are improved in the college. We have Gymnasium with modern equipment. It has full access and open to the students from 6 am to 9 am & 3pm to 6pm in working days. Some of the students got Medals in University , National and International levels.
- The college has established anti-ragging committee to eradicate the evil practice of ragging, by all means. To enlighten the students with regard to anti-ragging act, an awareness program was conducted. Besides this, we displayed the salient features of the act at the entrance gate of the college.
- Apart from the regular activities of NSS, students are also involved in various awareness activities on sanitation and nutrition, personal hygiene, preventive measures against fevers like malaria, dengue, swineflu etc.
- It is further planned to enroll more number of students in NSS unit to develop a sense of social responsibility, community service, patriotism and nationalism among the students through social service.
- Women empowerment cell has also resolved to conduct more meetings and awareness programs to sensitize girls on women's safety.
- Eco club has also resolved to conduct more meetings and awareness programs on Environment and plantation.
