Proceedings of the session

A faculty guidance session was conducted on 16th of December at seminar hall. The session was led by Ms.N.vasanthi, Dept In-charge of English with a presentation on the topic, '**On how to teach subjects in English language**'. The session was attended by the entire faculty team of S.G.K, Government Degree College headed by principal, Mr.Srinivasa Rao who extended his welcome address on the importance of the topic and handed over the session to the presenter. - Useful tips

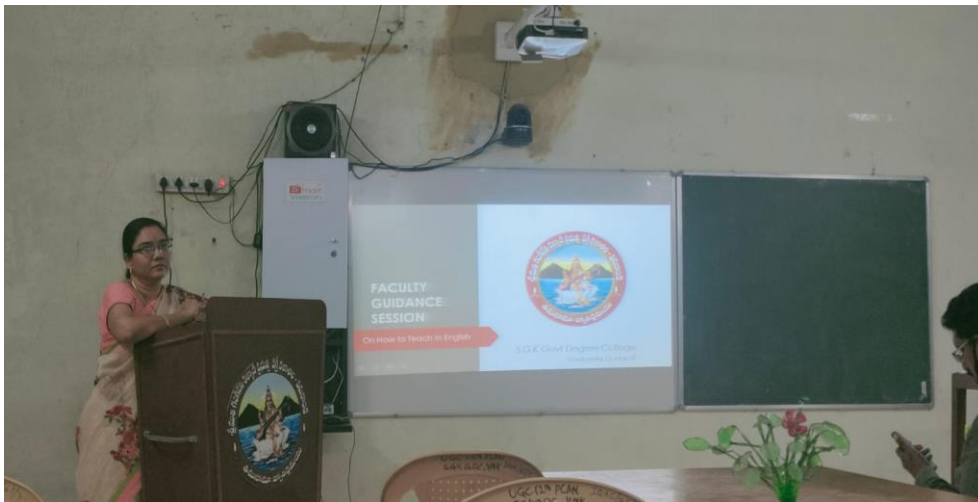
