Brief Report of the lecture

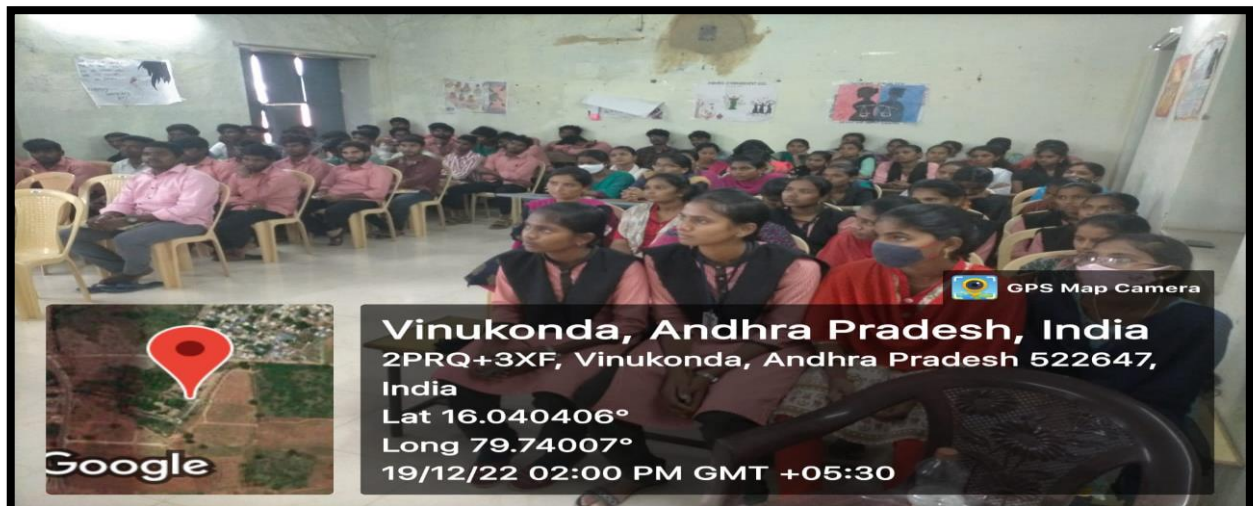
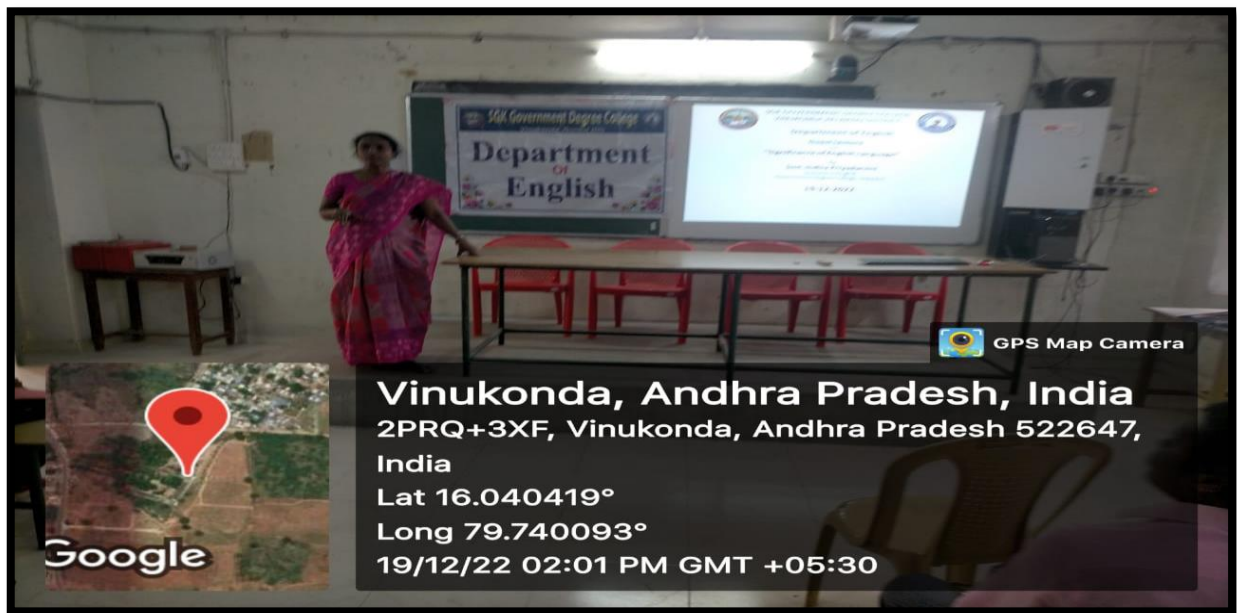

Outcomes:

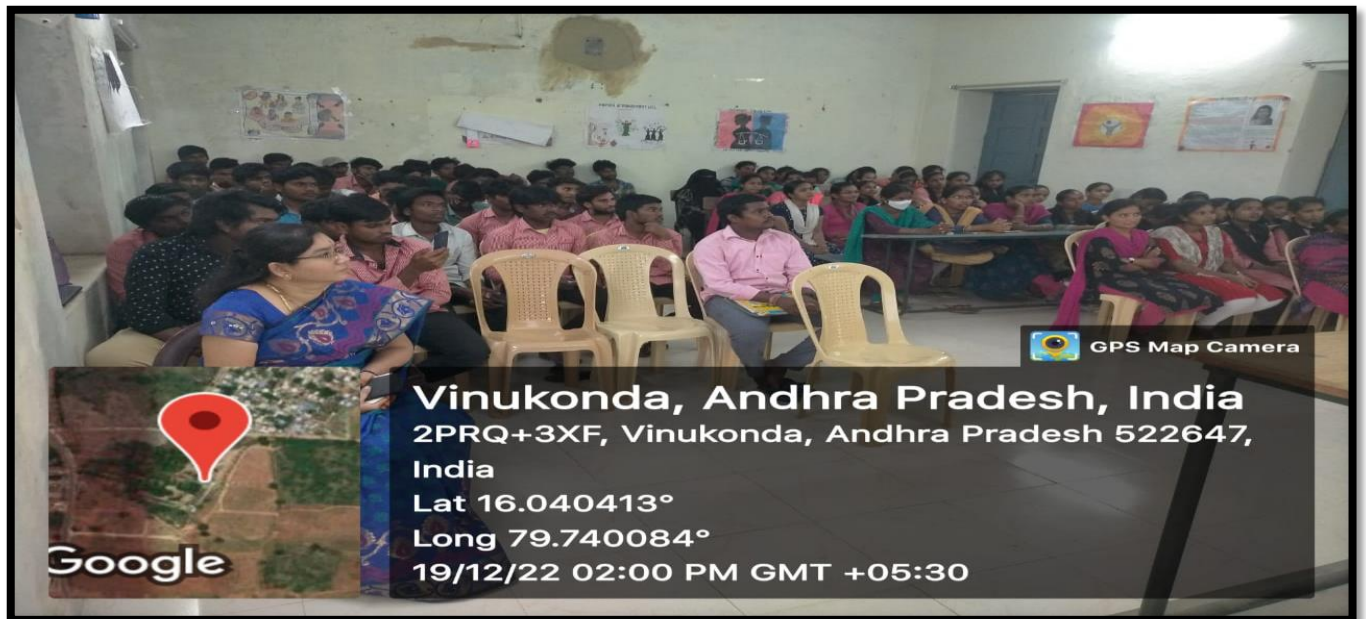
- Students were able to understand the importance of English
